


To nurture, Nature

- Encourage them to speak politely.
It is also important that your child learns to converse in English. Here are some tips...
 - ❖ The child should say his/her name in a full sentence.
 - ❖ Teach the child to use short sentences.
- For e.g.
 - ❖ May I go to the washroom?
 - ❖ Please open my water bottle/lunchbox.
 - ❖ May I drink water?
 - ❖ May I come in?
 - ❖ Converse with the child in English using small sentences. Drill phonic sounds .Do picture reading.
- Follow dinning etiquettes.
- Take small bites, chew food slowly with closed mouth.
- Button/unbutton his/her shirt.
- Tie his/her shoe laces.
- Learn to tidy up your room and keep your toys and books in place.



Inculcate personal hygiene in your child:

- Let's brush our teeth twice in a day.
- Let's comb our hair regularly.
- Let's bathe everyday.
- Let's wash our hands before and after meal.
- Let's trim our nails and keep them clean.

- Tracing of letters in a sandpit or using wheat floor on a flat surface, free hand writing (sky writing).
- Lacing activity(tie your shoe lace)

Sensory activities

- Finger/thumb painting

- Making the child throw and catch a ball.


General Instructions for Parents :




