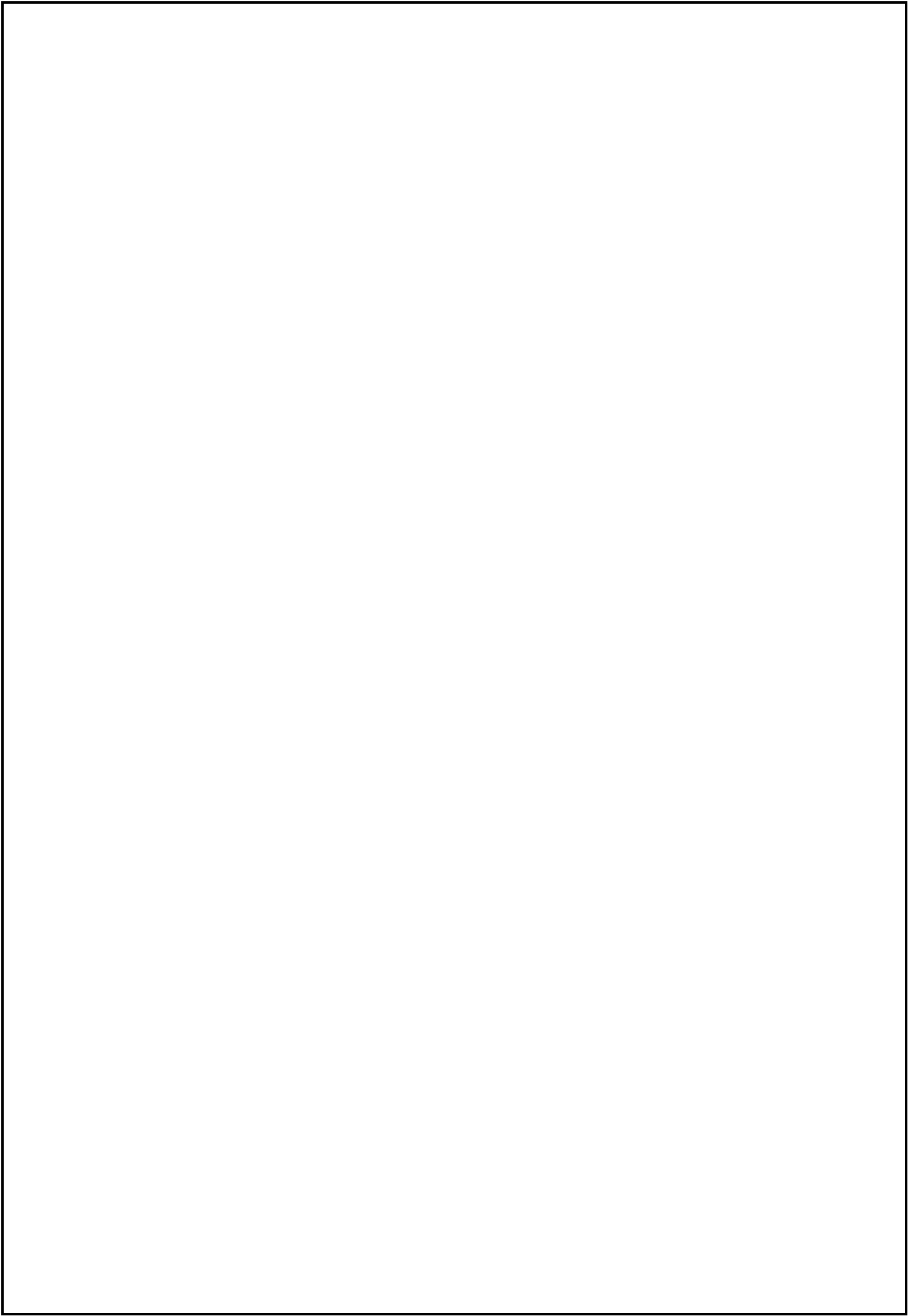

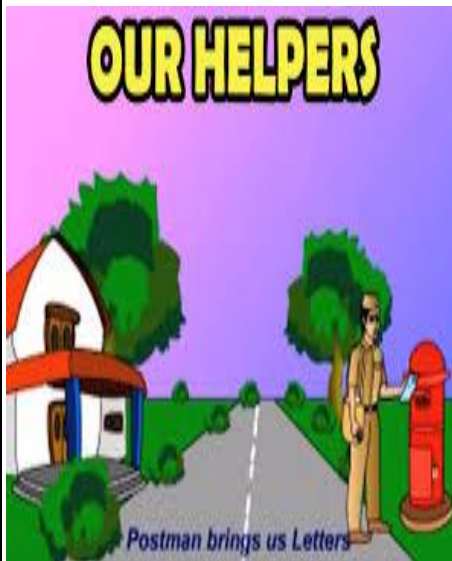

Till all are shining

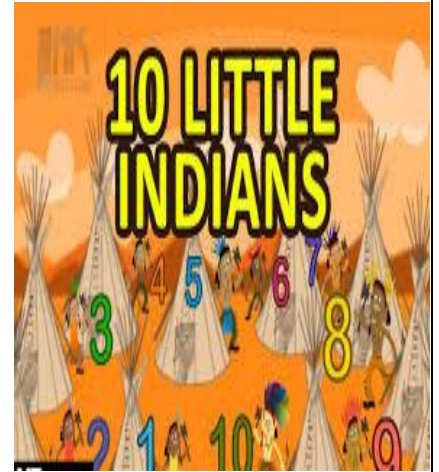

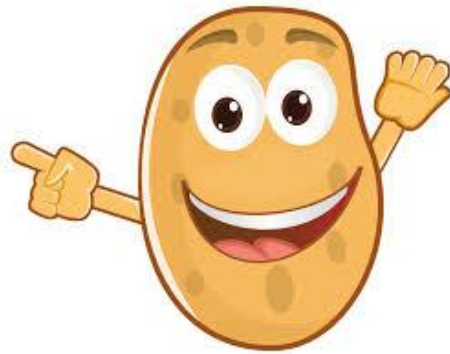

Take a car

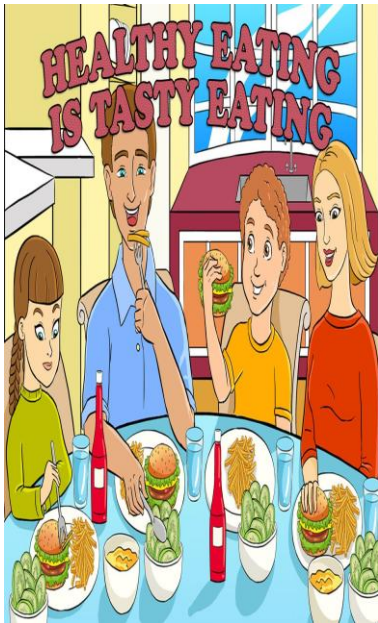

They try to get their parties to mix

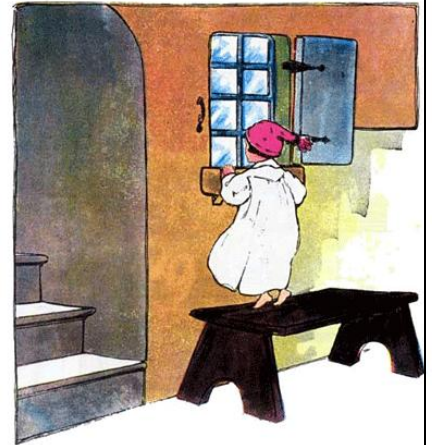
By supplying their guests with pogo sticks

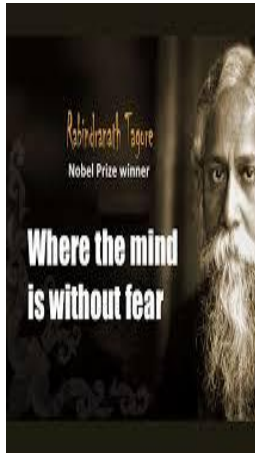
And when their fun at last abates,

On every golden scale!

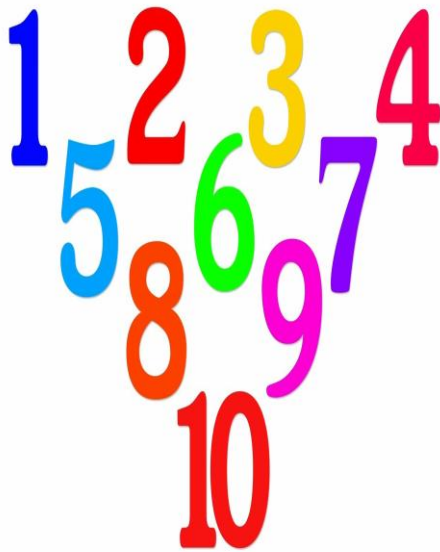
How cheerfully he seems to grin

With gently smiling jaws!





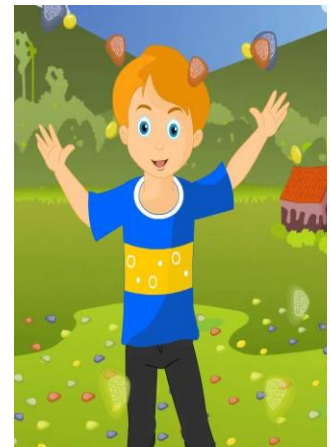
NOW WE ARE SIX
