I love the rain!



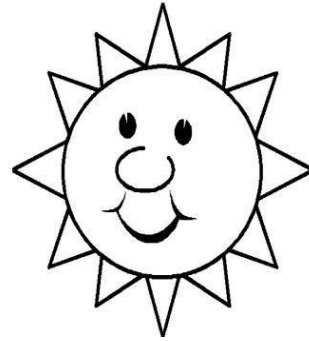
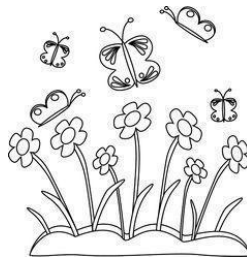
## ALL OF ME

Rat a tat-tat,

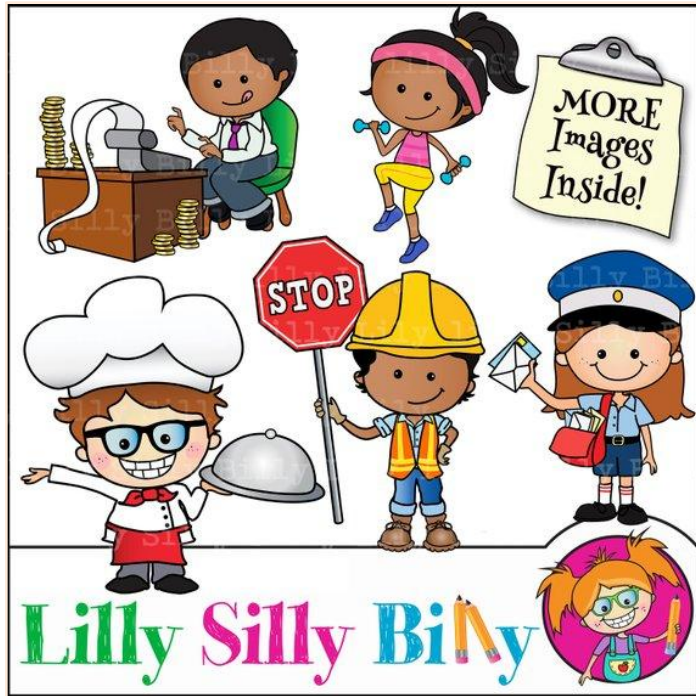


Watch how my hammer goes,

I bring, bring, bring.



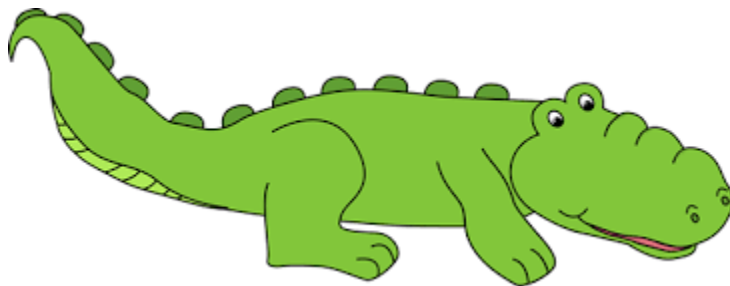
## JELLY BEANS
